Our Savior's Way Lutheran Church to host Ashburn Community Worship Service for National Day of Prayer

ASHBURN, Virginia - April 23 - Our Savior's Way Lutheran Church will be participating in the 56th Annual National Day of Prayer on Thursday, May 3, 2007. The church is located at 43115 Waxpool Road in Ashburn, Virginia and will be open from 7am until 7pm that day. Church leaders will be available for the first 10 minutes of each hour during the daytime vigil and there will be a worship service at 7:30 for the community. Everyone in the community is invited to stop by anytime during the day to have a quiet place to pray and to attend the evening service.

The theme for this year's Annual National Day of Prayer is "America, Unite in Prayer". The National Day of Prayer tradition predates the founding of the United States of America, evidenced by the Continental Congress' proclamation in 1775 setting aside a day of prayer. In 1952, Congress established an annual day of prayer and, in 1988, that law was amended, designating the National Day of Prayer as the first Thursday in May.

Our Savior's Way Lutheran Church, along with the Open Arms Christian Child Development Center, has served families in the Ashburn area for over 10 years. They are located at the intersection of Waxpool Road and Claiborne Parkway (Exit 5 of the Greenway and 1 mile south) and are currently expanding their facility to provide room for additional community activities.
