Christian Seder Dinner to be held at Our Savior's Way on April 9

ASHBURN, VA – March 9: Our Savior's Way Lutheran Church in Ashburn will be celebrating Maundy Thursday during Easter week with a Christian Seder dinner on April 9 at 6:30PM. The community is invited to attend the dinner and childcare will be available. Food served will include hardboiled eggs, charoset (an apple and walnut salad), lamb, mashed potatoes and mixed vegetables. There is no charge to attend.

A Christian Seder is a celebration of Holy Communion in the context of a meal, just as Jesus instituted Communion in the context of the Passover meal which He shared with His disciples on the night of his arrest. The Passover meal recalled for the Old Testament people the events of the Exodus, the great Old Testament act of deliverance. Our meal will be based on the Passover Seder. Some of the food items that would have been on the Passover table will be used. We will make it a New Testament meal which celebrates the great New Testament act of deliverance, the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Our Savior's Way, along with the Open Arms Christian Child Development Center, has provided a caring atmosphere for children and families in the Ashburn area for over 10 years. Open Arms is open to children from 6 weeks to 12 years old and offers preschool, full daycare, after-school programs, and summer camp. They are located at the intersection of Waxpool Road and Claiborne Parkway (1 mile south of Exit 5 of the Greenway) and have just completed expanding their facility to provide room for additional preschool, full daycare and community services.
