Holy Week, Easter services to be held at Our Savior's Way Lutheran Church

ASHBURN, VA - April 1: Our Savior's Way Lutheran Church will be celebrating Holy Week and Easter with several worship services beginning on Thursday, April 9th. There will be a Maundy Thursday seder dinner at 6:30pm on April 9th. The dinner is a celebration of Holy Communion in the context of a meal. Jesus instituted Communion in the context of the Passover meal which He shared with His disciples on the night of his arrest. The Passover meal recalls the events of the Exodus, the great Old Testament act of deliverance. Some of the food items that would have been on the Passover table will be used. The meal will consist of lamb, mashed potatoes, green beans and apple-walnut salad. Childcare will be available. The Good Friday service will be held on April 10th at 7:30pm. There will be four services on Easter Sunday, April 12 - a 6:30am sunrise service and the regular 8:00am, 9:30am and 11:00am services. Child care is available during all services (except 6:30am). A light breakfast will be served after each of the services in the fellowship hall. The community is welcome and encouraged to join us to celebrate this most important holiday celebrating the resurrection of Jesus Christ!

Our Savior's Way, along with the Open Arms Christian Child Development Center, has provided a caring atmosphere for the children of families in the Ashburn area for almost 10 years. Open Arms is open to children from 6 weeks to 12 years old and offers preschool, day care, before/after school care, and summer camp. They are located at the intersection of Waxpool Road and Claiborne Parkway (1 mile south of Exit 5 of the Greenway) and are currently expanding their facility to provide room for additional preschool, child care and community services.
