

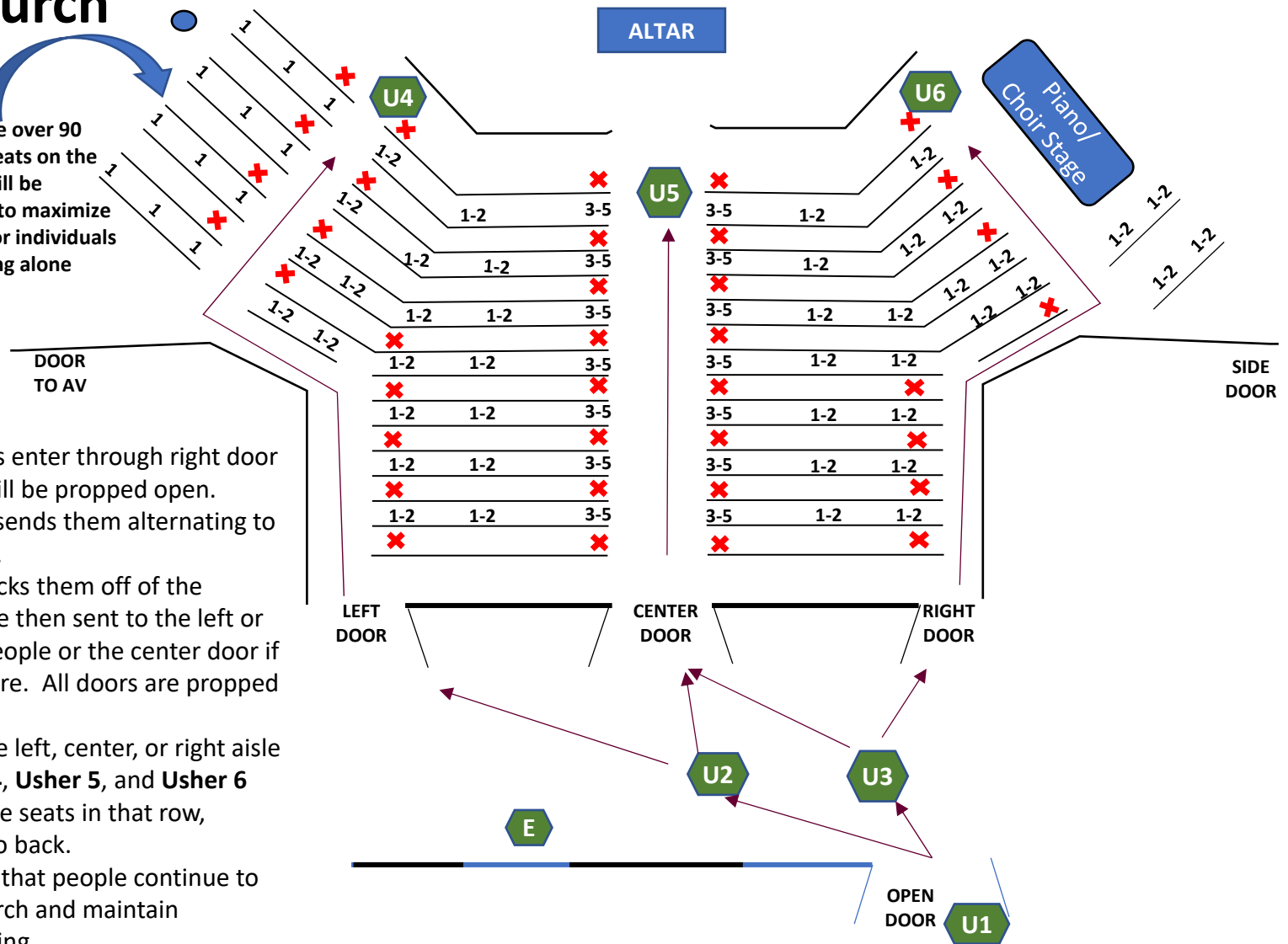
Entry to Church

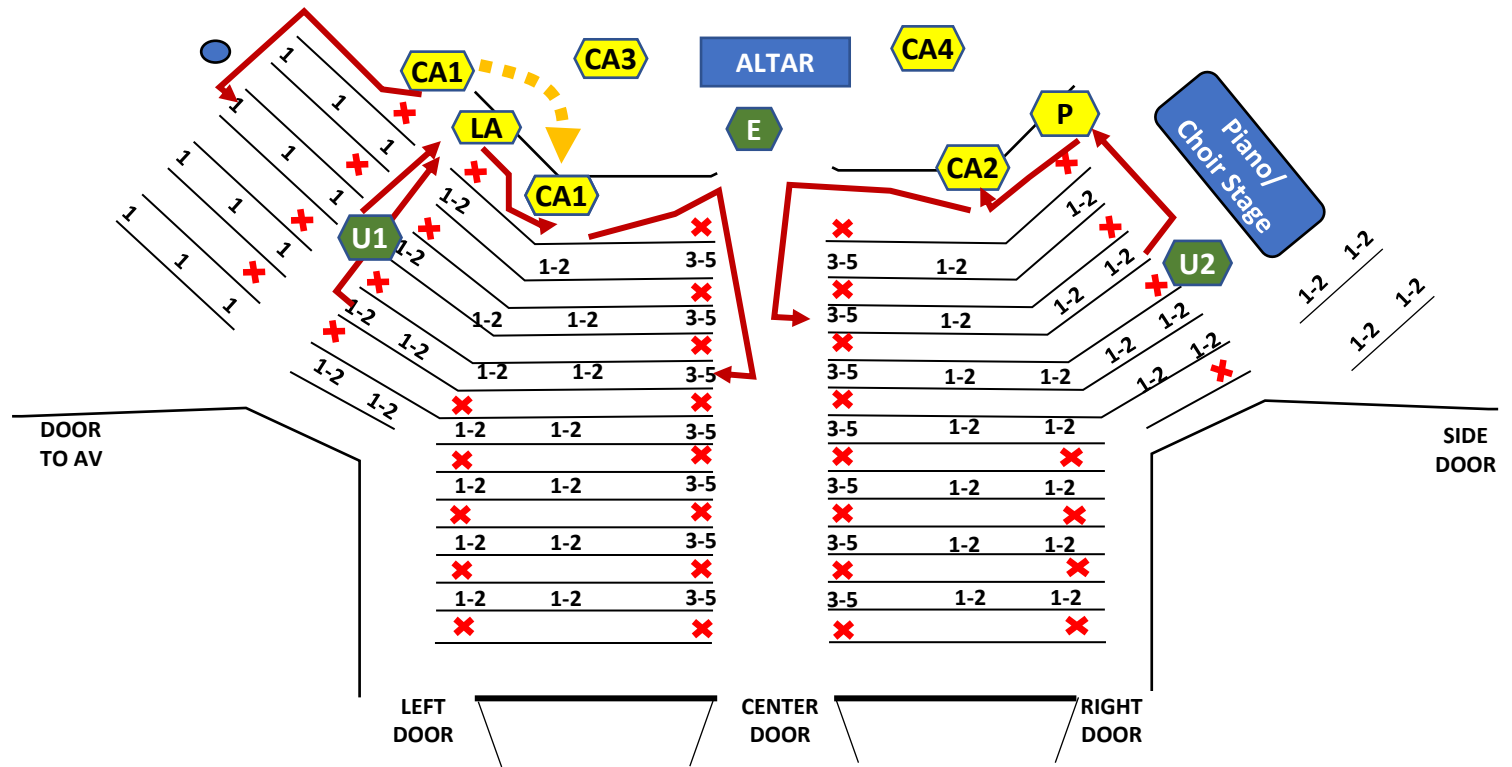

If we have over 90 attend, seats on the far-left will be adjusted to maximize seating for individuals worshipping alone

1. Congregation members enter through right door from parking lot, which will be propped open. **Usher 1** greets them and sends them alternating to either **Usher 2** or **Usher 3**.
2. **Usher 2** or **Usher 3** checks them off of the **reservation list**.^{*} They are then sent to the left or right doors if it is 1 or 2 people or the center door if it is a family of 3, 4, or more. All doors are propped open.
3. They proceed down the left, center, or right aisle toward the front. **Usher 4**, **Usher 5**, and **Usher 6** points to the next available seats in that row, seating them from front to back.
4. **Ushers 7 and 8** ensure that people continue to flow forward into the church and maintain appropriate social distancing.

^{*}If they are not on the list they are told to wait outside and may be seated if seats are available.





1. After the words of institution, the pastor will provide instruction that congregation members are to approach the front of the church from the side aisle. Congregants will receive and consume the wafer as the body of Christ and the individual cup of wine as the blood of Christ. Some may choose the sealed packets and others may receive a Gluten free wafer from the Elder positioned in the middle. Depending on the quantity of those requesting sealed packets we may add an additional communion assistant to distribute the sealed packets.
2. On the left side, the liturgical assistant (LA) with tray of bread and Communion Assistant 1 (CA1) with tray of wine will position themselves at the head of the left-side aisle. Usher 1 will first release the side section pews from front to back up the left-side aisle for communion. Those sitting in the side section will commune and then reenter their pew from the far side aisle (by the baptismal font). After the side section has communed, CA1 will move to the altar side of the LA so that the center-left section can commune.
3. On the right side, the Pastor (P) with tray of bread and Communion Assistant 2 (CA2) with tray of wine will position themselves at the head of the right-side aisle. Usher 2 will release pews from front to back up the right-side aisle for communion. Those few on the far right will follow the same process, walk down the center aisle and then return to their seats up the side aisle.
4. After individuals have received and consumed communion, they will proceed to the center aisle. If two people approach the center aisle at the same time, they will briefly pause and alternate to maintain social distancing. They will use the center aisle to return to their seats.
5. Communion Assistants 3 and 4 (CA3 and CA4) take the place of acolytes and refill both the trays of wine and bread as necessary.
